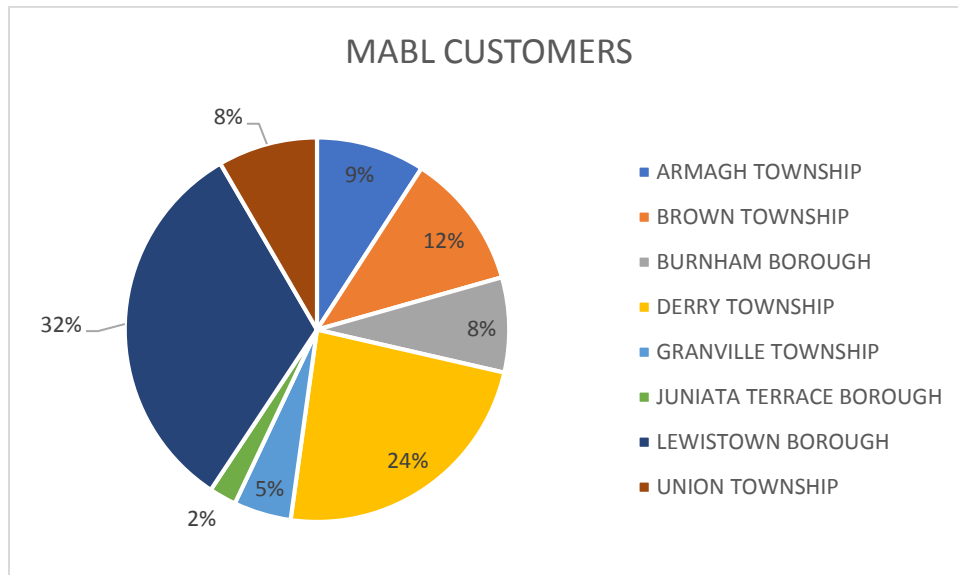
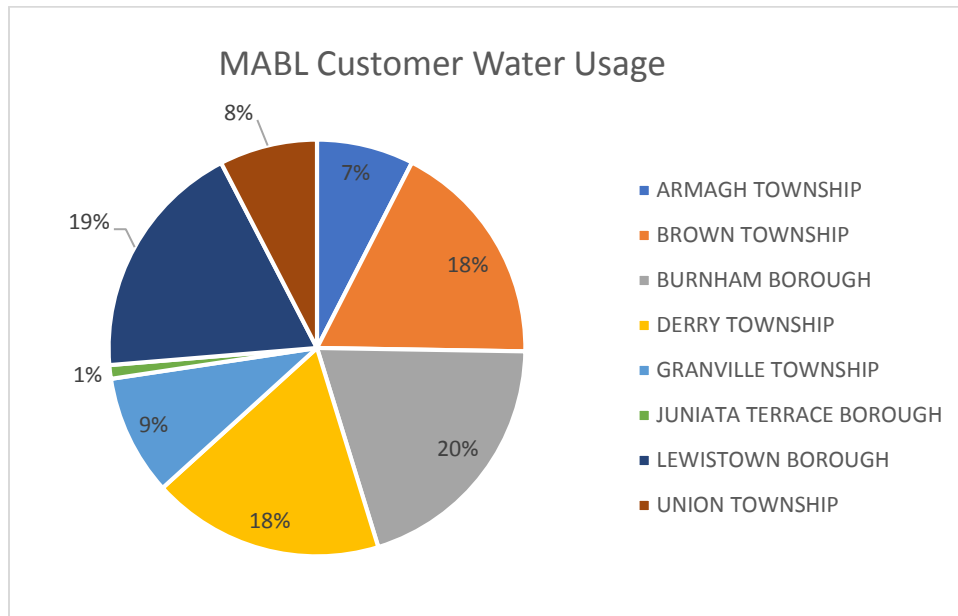


MABL Proudly Serving Our Customers in Mifflin County



Did you know the Laurel Creek Filtration Plant provides almost 3,000,000 gallons of water each day to MABL Customers?

Did you know MABL maintains an extremely low percentage of lost water?

The PA Department of Environmental Protection (PA DEP) expects a rate of 20%, or lower, of lost water known as “unaccounted for water”. MABL has been below the DEP requirement 4 consecutive years and 7 of the last 10! The MABL Staff actively completes leak detection and monitors daily water flows to optimize this important resource management task.

Did you know The Laurel Creek Filtration Plant has been recognized for 11 consecutive years by PA DEP’s Area Wide Optimization Program (AWOP)?

The AWOP Award is a national recognition co-sponsored by the US-EPA, PA DEP and the Association of State Drinking Water Administrators for outstanding filter plant performance. Twenty-two states participate in the program. Its goal is to encourage water plants to go beyond what is legally required and produce the best water quality possible. That includes submitting more water quality data than required, and analyzing that data to find deficiencies. This effort is another key indicator of employee dedication and MABL working to provide the highest quality water possible.
